

# CLIPPCases

## *Instructions for registering & logging in*

Go to: [www.clippcases.org](http://www.clippcases.org)

### *New user:*

- Click "register"
- Type in your email address; first & last names; student status
- Click "OK"
- You will be sent a login & password in two email messages. **Be sure to save both - your log-in name cannot be changed.**

### *Registered user:*

- Click "Go to cases" at left of screen
- Login with login & password; case selection page opens
- Click name of desired case or "open case" to right of name

The system keeps track of which cases you access, and if you complete them.
